Olga received her formal academic art education in the Art School in Kazan, Russia, graduating with honors. While mostly self-taught in oils, she has studied with Jeremy Lipking (oil classes and workshop) and Glen Orbik (figurative and portrait drawing classes, California Art Institute). She has taken several prizes throughout her career and exhibits through organizations including the Oil Painters of America, Portrait Society of America, and California Art Club.
