raceful Subtleties, upcoming at Principle Gallery G in Alexandria, Virginia, will feature the work of two married couples, Jussi Pöyhönen and Paula Rubino, and Charles Weed and Louise Fenne.

Finland and Florida are juxtaposed in Pöyhönen's paintings. "After living in bright and very colorful Florida for six years it was nice to get back to Finland and witness the subtleties of grav days and the joyous differences of seasons," he says of his paintings Early Spring and Baltic Sea II. On the other end of the spectrum, Coconut depicts a traditionally tropical Florida.

Rubino will also take viewers across the globe with her paintings of subject matter from Florida to Syria. *Laji* depicts a young refugee, while her Florida landscapes bring attention to ecosystems threatened by human interference. "Almost every painting I make is informed by observing the world around me, whether it's the news or a grapefruit," Rubino says. "The social commentary is rarely obvious to the viewer, but it is a constant narrative in my mind."

As a twist on traditional portraits, Fenne adds parrots to her paintings. Without a filter, their mimicry acts as a mirror for humans' innermost thoughts. She says, "I enjoy their association with being a link between the human world and that of nature, allowing a deeper mutual understanding through their ability to imitate human sound, acting as interpreters or a bridge between the two."

Weed will be showing both portraits and landscapes in multiple mediums, including the oil Winter Portrait, Pine Forest. Of his process, he says, "My motivation is not so much to make things, which is really more of a byproduct, but to enjoy the process, materially and otherwise."

An opening reception will be held on April 7 from 6:30 to 9 p.m. at Principle Gallery, and Graceful Subtleties will remain on view until May 9.
