About the Artist: Geoffrey Johnson

Geoffrey Johnson is a contemporary impressionist painter, who was born in Greensboro, North Carolina in 1965. He graduated from the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts where he received numerous awards and prizes for his artistic merit. Johnson has exhibited in galleries and venues throughout the United States since 1995. His paintings hang in private and corporate collections such as, Coca-Cola, Turner Broadcasting, BellSouth, and Wachovia Bank.

Johnson absorbs his inspirations from his personal travels and first-hand observations. New York City is an especially major influence of his, he praises the city because; "It doesn't call for color." says Johnson, "A limited palette brings more of the mood of the city out of me. More of how I feel about it." The artist uses a monochromatic palette primarily consisting of sepia hues. Reviewers have noted Johnson's special ability to capture groups of people and things en masse in his work while inviting quiet introspection. He has also been recognized for the manner in which he expresses the captivating space between abstraction and realism.

In addition, Johnson is drawn to work, personal, and interior spaces. Finding artistry in a box of vintage photographs, which has led him to sepia toned interiors combined with experimentation. The artist tends to broaden his palette by adding brighter colors into the mix of sepia tones to reveal details and beauty within interiors. Many have admired his paintings for their elegant sense of melancholy and timelessness.

In his studio, Geoffrey Johnson prefers to work on numerous paintings at once in an attempt to keep ideas original and avoid being restricted by a single style. He currently lives and works in Winston-Salem, North Carolina along with his family.
