### About the Artist: Robert Liberace

Robert Liberace's work is motivated by centuries of knowledge and skill exemplified by the great masters. He aims to combine his fascination with technique, anatomy, and art history to produce work in a variety of disciplines such as drawing, watercolor, sculpture, and painting. Liberace earned his B.F.A. and M.F.A. from George Washington University where he originally attended school on a baseball scholarship, and later with art scholarships from the National Society of Arts and Letters.

He is well known for the draftsmanship and movement of his figure work. The Art Renewal Center selected the artist as a "Living Master," and he's an honorary member of the American China Oil Painting Artists League. Liberace is a visiting instructor at The National Gallery of Art in Washington, DC, where he demonstrates old masters' techniques. He is very well known for his inspiring and informative teaching style. Liberace is an instructor at The Art League of Virginia and holds workshops throughout the United States as well as abroad. He regularly tours his students through the great museums of Europe, garnering from his extensive knowledge of the old European masters. Liberace also pioneered one of the first online teaching courses for American Artist magazine, which included live webinars and critiques. In response to the increasing need for classical art instruction, the Liberace Studio has produced a series of tutorial DVD's.

In addition to painting, Liberace is a very talented sculptor. He was chosen as a professional member of the National Sculpture Society. He has sculpted a series of carved marble reliefs, which now permanently reside in the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington D.C. A life sized marble statue of Mother Teresa also occupies the Shrine, which was based on Liberace's design. A fifteen foot crucifix the artist created now hangs above the alter in "Our Lady of Mercy" church in Potomac, Maryland.

Robert Liberace has received a number of awards from International Portrait Competitions and he is a professional member of the National Sculpture Society. He has been commissioned to paint portraits for George H. Bush,

Ambassador Sol Linowitz, and the long-time Director of the National Portrait Gallery, Marc Pachter. Liberace currently lives in Virginia with his wife Lina Liberace, and their two daughters.
